


MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES


June 2nd 2020


The Middletown Town Council met at 7:00 P.M. Council Members Dick Schwalm, Gary Kendall, Jake Smith, Dave Wagner and Dan Fountain were present. Town Attorney Joel Harvey was present.


1. Ordinance 2020-1, **AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE DIRECTION OF TRAFFIC ON AN ALLEY WITHIN THE TOWN OF MIDDLETOWN** was presented for its' second reading. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving the ordinance Motion carried 5-0.
2. Ordinance 2020-2, **AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE RATES AND CHARGES FOR SERVICE OF THE TOWN'S WATERWORKS** was presented for its' second reading. This ordinance eliminates the Town paying a hydrant rental fee to the water utility. It is being considered due the expected financial impact of COVID-19. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded passing the ordinance. Motion carried 5-0.
3. The Budget Calendar for the 2021 budget was introduced
4. The 2021 Salary Ordinance was introduced
5. A proposed General Fund budget was presented for consideration
6. Council President Jake Smith signed the documents for the town to participate in the Indiana Finance Authority Coronavirus Relief Fund.
7. Patty Schwalm gave an update on the Middletown Farmers Market
8. Council discussed a response to a letter from Liberty Mutual Insurance concerning Workmen's Comp issues
9. A new agreement with BFS for the 2nd phase of the CCMG grant was presented
10. Council asked attorney Joel Harvey to send a letter to the owners of 503 N 10th street expressing concern about an abandoned pool in the back yard. The property is currently vacant.
11. The council discussed a timeline for reopening the Utility Office for public access. It was tentatively scheduled for the week of July 4th.


There being nothing further brought before the council, the meeting was adjourned.


