


MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES


September 1st 2020


The Middletown Town Council met at 7:00 P.M. All members were present. Town Attorney Joel Harvey was present


1. President Jake Smith presented Gary Redick with a proclamation making September Lions Club Appreciation Month.
2. It was discussed hiring Bruce Berg as an on-call electrical lineman. Council asked Town Attorney Joel Harvey to prepare an agreement for both sides to sign.
3. Tony Shriner from IAMGIS gave a presentation on their services involving GIS mapping of utilities.
4. The closeout letter for INDOT grant DES 1900957 was presented. This involved paving a number of streets this past summer. Dave Wagner motioned and Dan Fountain seconded closing out the grant. Motion carried 5-0
5. COVID Relief fund application #4 was presented. This was requesting reimbursement for the Lucas device purchased by the EMS. Dan Fountain motioned and Dick Schwalm seconded to submit the application to IFA. Motion carried 5-0.
6. The 2021 salary ordinance was presented. Dan Fountain motioned and Dick Schwalm seconded approving the ordinance. Motion carried 5-0.
7. Clerk-Treasurer Tim Mundell informed the council that Carl Spears had not been receiving his extra pay for having a CDL license due to the Clerk-Treasurers oversight. It will be corrected on the next payroll.
8. Carl Spears informed the council that the fuel pump was out on the International Bucket Truck. It will cost about 2500.00 to get it repaired..
9. Carl Spears requested to purchase a trailer from Pritchetts Excavating for 3800.00. Dave Wagner motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving the purchase. Motion carried 5-0


There being nothing further brought before the council, the meeting was adjourned.


