


MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES


October 6th 2020


The Middletown Town Council met at 7:00 P.M. All members were present. Town Attorney Joel Harvey was present


1. Dan Fountain motioned and Dick Schwalm seconded adopting Ordinance 2020-4, the 2021 budget .Motion carried 5-0.
2. Dave Wagner motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving an agreement with BFS for assistance in preparing a CCMG-02 grant application. The total agreement not to exceed 26,000.00 Motion carried 5-0.
3. Dave Wagner motioned and Gary Kendal seconded signing the sales agreement with IAMGIS. Motion carried 5-0..
4. Dan Fountain motioned and Dick Schwalm seconded signing the final sales agreement with Revize Software. Motion carried 5-0.
5. The council approved signing and submitting IFA Covid Reimbursement request #5.
6. The council set 4:00 P.M. until 7:00 P.M. on Saturday, October 31st as official trick-or-treat hours.
7. Amanda Riwitis reported that the new K-9 Chrisz has completed training with Officer Hunt and that they are now on duty.
8. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded hiring Taylor Brown as a part-time utility employee at Grade 5.Motion carried 5-0.
9. Gary Kendall motioned and Dick Schwalm seconded hiring another utility employee at no higher than Grade 6. Based on how some interviews go this week.
10. The council approved hiring Yardberry Construction to haul some waste from around our wells. They approved 150.00 per load with a total cost of not more than 5,000.00.
11. Carl Spears reported that his 2020 Silverado had been backed into while parked in a parking lot. The quote to fix it was 1600.00. Because of the 1000.00 deductible, Dan Fountain motioned and Dick Schwalm seconded fixing the damage at our own expense. Motion carried 5-0..


There being nothing further brought before the council, the meeting was adjourned.
