


MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES




The Middletown Town Council met at 7:00 P.M with all members present. Town Attorney Joel Harvey was present


1. Penny York gave a presentation on resources available from the Henry County EDC.
2. Dan Fountain motioned and Dave Wagner seconded approving Ordinance 2020-5 on its' third reading. This ordinance raises the fees charged to customers of the Water Utility. Motion carried 5-0.
3. Dave Wagner motioned and Dan Fountain seconded approving Ordinance 2020-6 on its' third reading. This ordinance raises the fees charged to customers of the Sewer Utility. Motion carried 5-0.
4. Dan Fountain motioned and Dick Schwalm seconded reducing Rick Hollingsworth from Grade 6 to Grade 5 utility worker. Motion carried 5-0.
5. The council discussed putting timers on the fire bay doors so they shut automatically. Carl Spears will look into it further.
6. Carl Spears discussed problems he was having with replacing a damaged utility pole at 10th street and Corporation Line Road. He keeps hitting buried utilities when trying to set a new pole.
7. Clerk-Treasurer Tim Mundell presented his Surety Bond for 2021 for approval. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving the bond. Motion carried 5-0.
