


MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES


February 2nd 2021


The Middletown Town Council met at 7:00 P.M with all members present. Town Attorney Joel Harvey was present


1. Dan Fountain moved to approve Ordinance 2021-1 on its' second reading. Gary Kendall seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.
2. Scott Emswiller gave an update on the computer system upgrade. It has been delayed due to a problem with Microsoft 365. Scott does not have a firm date when this problem is expected to be resolved.
3. Amanda Riwitis discussed possibly trading in older weapons for new ones. She is still investigating it..
4. Carl Spears questioned cars being parked on Locust Street during heavy snow. What is the procedure for having them towed?
5. Carl Spears had the hole hydro-vacced at 10th and Corporation Line to set the new utility pole.
6. Carl Spears discussed problems he was having with replacing a damaged utility pole at 10th street and Corporation Line Road. He keeps hitting buried utilities when trying to set a new pole.
7. Clerk-Treasurer Tim Mundell requested the posting order for utility payments be changed to Electric, Water, Sewer, Trash then Stormwater. Dave Wagner motioned and Dan Fountain seconded approving. Motion carried 5-0

There being nothing further brought before the council, the meeting was adjourned.


