


# MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

September 7th 2021


The Middletown Town Council held a meeting on September 7th, 2021. All members were present.


1. Christy Ragle and Shelly Harter from Henry County Destination Development gave a presentation on the county's effort to attract tourism to the area.
2. Gina Ballard and Laurie Morgan gave an update on the Fall Funfest plans.
3. Norm Perdue gave a presentation on creating and maintaining a five year plan.
4. Ordinance 2021-8 which amends the parking schedule was read on it's second reading. The Ordinance as written, allows no parking on the North side of Locust Street from 6<sup>th</sup> street to a point 40' West of 6<sup>th</sup>. The council also wants to have no parking from the alley in front of the city building west to seventh street. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving the ordinance with the proposed change added. Motion carried 5-0.
5. Kevin Rednour questioned trees being cut in his woods. It is believed to be a contractor working on Honey Creek Trail.
6. Amanda Riwitis discussed the sidewalk in the 1100 block of Locust. She believes the Town may be responsible for it from previous work on a water line. Dan Fountain motioned and Dave Wagner seconded having Carl Spears repair it if it is found the Town was responsible.
7. Amanda Riwitis reported that she has had questions from residents about our burn ordinance. She is looking at rewriting it to make it less confusing.


There being nothing further brought before the council, the meeting was adjourned.


