


MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES


October 5th 2021

The Middletown Town Council held a meeting on September 21st, 2021. All members were present.

1. Clerk-Treasurer Tim Mundell gave the oath of office to new Police Reserve Officer Brian Daley
2. Council President Jake Smith opened a public hearing on Ordinance 2021-9. An Ordinance vacating a right of way at 210 S 8th. President Smith closed the hearing with no public comment.
3. Dave Wagner motioned and Dick Schwalm seconded passing Ordinance 2021-9 on its' second reading. Motion carried 5-0.
4. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving Ordinance 2021-10. This Ordinance creates the 2022 budget for the Town. Motion carried 5-0.
5. Ambassadors of Gods Creatures Executive Director Susan Blake gave a presentation on the services offered in regard to stray cats.
6. The Council approved a plan for premium pay for employees from the ARP monies. Attorney Joel Harvey will prepare an ordinance for the plan.
7. Gary Kendall motioned and Dave Wagner seconded giving employees a 25 cent per hour pay raise in the 2022 Salary Ordinance. Motion carried 5-0.
8. Jake Smith appointed Matt Moore to the Middletown/Fall Creek Township Library Board to finish the term of Amy Morris, who resigned. The term runs through January of 2023.
9. The Fall Cleanup days will be November 4th, 5th and 6th from 9-5 each day.
10. Guy Cobb is retiring from the Police Department. His last day of work was October 5th.
11. Carl Spears expressed concern about plans to move a storm drain on the Honey Creek Trail.
12. The paving of the alley behind the Library has been completed.

There being nothing further brought before the council, the meeting was adjourned.
