


MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

October 19th 2021

The Middletown Town Council held a meeting on October 19th, 2021. All members were present.


1. Ordinance 2021-9, an Ordinance vacating a right of way at 210 S, 8th, was presented for its' third and final reading. Dave Wagner motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving the ordinance. Motion carried 5-0.
2. Council President Jake Smith opened a public hearing on Resolution 10-19-2021-1. A resolution approving additional appropriations to certain funds. President Smith closed the hearing with no public comment.
3. Dave Wagner motioned and Dan Fountain seconded passing Resolution 10-19-2021-1. Motion carried 5-0.
4. Resolution 10-19-2021-2 was presented. This is a resolution appropriating ARP funds for employee premium pay. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving the resolution. Motion carried 4-0. Dave Wagner recused himself from the discussion because of relatives receiving the pay.
5. The 2022 salary ordinance was presented. Dave Wagner motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving on its' first reading. Motion carried 5-0..
6. The council agreed to table the MOU with Ambassadors of Gods Creatures until the next meeting.
7. November 4th 5th and 6th will be the Town Cleanup days.
8. Carl Spears presented quotes for a new truck. One is needed for salt spreading and plowing. Dave Wagner motioned and Gary Kendall seconded purchasing a 2022 Silverado from Sam Pierce Chevrolet for 48,599. The money will be a temporary loan from the Electric Utility and repaid over a five year period..
9. The council agreed to hire Ernie Bond as a part time tree trimmer at Grade 7. The employment will be contingent on the results of an interview with Gary Kendall. Dave Wagner motioned and Dan Fountain seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

There being nothing further brought before the council, the meeting was adjourned.
