


MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES


November 2nd 2021


The Middletown Town Council held a meeting on November 2nd, 2021. All members were present.


1. Annie Smith, from the Christmas parade committee, reported the parade was planned for December 4th at 4:00 P.M. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving the route being from the Park up Locust Street to the Fire Station. Motion carried 5-0 .
2. Resolution 11-02-2021-1, which accepted the County Planning Commissions' recommendation to approve the TIF area expansion, was presented. Dan Fountain motioned and Dick Schwalm seconded approving the resolution. Motion carried 5-0.
3. The 2022 salary ordinance was read on its' second reading. Dave Wagner motioned and Dan Fountain seconded approving the ordinance. Motion carried 5-0.
4. Carl Spears reported that the 2022 Silverado was only a 2-wheel drive instead of 4-wheel as originally thought. Council member Dan Fountain will meet with the dealership to discuss our options.
5. Amanda Riwitis discussed the recent problems with power to the city building and our phone system. The council discussed getting a landline reinstalled for the dispatch phone instead of using VOIP for them.

There being nothing further brought before the council, the meeting was adjourned.
