


MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES


November 16th 2021


The Middletown Town Council held a meeting on November 16th, 2021. All members were present.


1. Bryant Margison, from Margison Graphics , gave a presentation on new LED signs to hang on the city building. We are planning on applying for a grant from the County Food and Beverage Tax to buy new signs.
2. Kim Hilbish, who owns a property on 950 North, discussed his plans for the property with the council. He wants to create a hobby farm. It will have pigs, cows, horses and goats. They are in the process of getting the property rezoned with the County Planning Commission at this time.
3. The 2022 Salary Ordinance was presented for its' third reading. Dave Wagner motioned and Dan Fountain seconded approving the Ordinance. Motion carried 5-0.
4. Resolution 11-16-2021-1 was presented. This resolution allows the council President to be the sole signature on INDOT paperwork for CCMG grants. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving the resolution. Motion carried 5-0.
5. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded to pay Anthony Biddle for time missed from the Police Academy due to an illness. Motion carried 5-0
6. Carl Spears reported that the blower motor on the furnace at the water plant needs replaced. Cost estimate of 1800.00
7. The painting and maintenance on the 236 water tower has been completed
8. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded buying all employees a 30.00 gift card from Harvest Market for Christmas.


There being nothing further brought before the council, the meeting was adjourned.
