December 7<sup>th</sup> 2021




The Middletown Town Council held a meeting on November 16th, 2021. Dan Fountain was absent.

1. Resolution 2021-12-07-1, a resolution expanding the TIF district was presented. Dave Wagner motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving the resolution. Motion carried 4-0.
2. A discussion was held on employees that have tested positive for COVID and how to pay them for the required quarantine period. Dave Wagner motioned and Gary Kendall seconded for the December 3<sup>rd</sup> payroll, paying employees for time missed because of quarantine if they can show proof of a positive COVID test. Motion carried 4-0.
3. The 2022 bond for Clerk-Treasurer Tim Mundell was presented. The bond is for 100,000. Dave Wagner motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving the bond. Motion carried 4-0.
4. IMPA tracker for the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of 2022 was presented. The rate will be 0.36836 per KWH. This is a decrease of .005476 per KWH from the current tracking factor. Dick Schwalm motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving the new rate. Motion carried 4-0
