

MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES


December 21st 2021


The Middletown Town Council held a meeting on December 21st, 2021. All members were present.


1. There was discussion on rezoning the Hilbish property on 950 North. The town has not received the official recommendation from the Henry County Planning Commission yet. The discussion will continue at the next meeting.
2. Arbor Homes has questioned whether our sewer system can handle another 70 homes on it. They also requested the depth of the sewer along 236 in front of Get Go area.
3. Resolution 12-21-2021-1, which transferred certain appropriations, was presented. Dave Wagner motioned and Dan Fountain seconded approving the resolution. Motion carried 5-0.
4. There was some discussion on reinstating the Hydrant Fee and how much it should be. No action was taken.
5. Dan Fountain motioned and Dave Wagner seconded paying an employee for time missed due to COVID quarantine on the December 31st payroll. Motion carried 5-0..
6. There was some discussion on tornado sirens in the area. Amanda Riwitis will investigate further.
7. The civic center walls need repair from tape being hung on the drywall. Carl Spears will look into it.


There being nothing further brought before the council, the meeting was adjourned.
