 3. Historical signs around town.


4. There was discussion about the Proposed PER agreement with BFR for a sewer plant. The discussion revolved around trying to build a new plant or upgrading the current one.


5. Matt Thompson was promoted to the position of Police Captain.


6. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded hiring Katelynn Boggs as a part-time dispatcher. Motion carried 5-0.




There being nothing further brought before the council, the meeting was adjourned.
