

MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES


The Middletown Town Council held a meeting on February 1st 2022. Jake Smith was absent, Dan Fountain arrived late.


1. Gary Kendall motioned and Dick Schwalm approving Ordinance 2022-1 on its' third and final reading. Motion carried 3-0


Dan Fountain arrived at the meeting.


2. There was discussion about maintain the backup generator at the cell tower and how to fund it. No action was taken.


There being nothing further brought before the council, the meeting was adjourned.
