

MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES


The Middletown Town Council held a meeting on March 15th 2022.


1. John Brand and Matt Speidel from Butler, Fairman and Siefert gave a presentation on the services offered in their proposal for a sewer system study.
2. Lohrey Masonry presented an estimate of 1050.00 to lower the brick wall in front of the city building. The wall needs to be lowered due to traffic concerns. Dave Wagner motioned and Dan Fountain seconded accepting the quote. Motion carried 5-0.
3. Ordinance 2022-2, an Ordinance creating a cell tower maintenance fund, was presented on its' first reading. Dan Fountain motioned and Dick Schwalm seconded approving the ordinance. Motion carried 5-0.
4. Amanda Riwitis recommended moving Anthony Biddle to Grade 5. Dave Wagner motioned and Dan Fountain seconded approving. Motion carried 5-0.
5. Carl Spears recommended hiring Kylee Alfrey part time at utility grade 5. Dean Fountain motioned and Dick Schwalm seconded. Motion carried 5-0.
6. Ron Koons gave a presentation on charging stations for electric vehicles. No action was taken.
7. Dave Wagner motioned and Dan Fountain seconded approving the Butler Fairman proposal for a wastewater system study. The fee is not to exceed 82,700.00 and will be paid from ARP monies. A roll call vote was requested.
