



MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES


The Middletown Town Council held a meeting on April 5th 2022. Gary Kendall was absent.


1. Change order #1 was presented for CCMG 2021-2 contract. It adds 15th street and part of 12th street to the contract. The town will pay for these out of pocket. Dave Wagner motioned and Dan Fountain seconded approving. Motion carried 4-0..
2. The notice to proceed for CCMG 2021-2 was presented. Dan Fountain motioned and Dave Wagner seconded approving. Motion carried 4-0.
3. Ordinance 2022-2, an Ordinance creating a cell tower maintenance fund, was presented on its' second reading. Dan Fountain motioned and Dick Schwalm seconded approving the ordinance. Motion carried 4-0.
4. There was discussion on the repeal of the Utility Receipts Tax. .
5. The second quarter electric tracker from IMPA was presented. It increases from .036836 to .053440. Dan Fountain motioned and Dave Wagner seconded approving. Motion carried 4-0.
6. Dave Wagner motioned and Dan Fountain seconded adjusting Derek Resler water bill again while it is sorted out of who owns what and the best way to re-route his water .
7. Amanda Riwitis reported the police department is having issues with the 2019 F150 and 2018 Silverado. Both might need extensive repairs.
8. Amanda Riwitis has been certified as a Divemaster and is on the Henry County Dive team.
9. There was a request to put a handicap parking spot in the town parking lot on North 5th street. Dan Fountain motioned and Dave Wagner seconded approving. Motion carried 4-0.
10. Carl Spears requested to hire Zachary Downard part time at 13.44/hr. Dan Fountain motioned and Dave Wagner seconded approving. Motion carried 4-0.
11. Carl Spears presented a proposed Salary Ordinance for the utility workers.
12. Matt Speidel from BFS gave a report on the Sewer study.


There being nothing further brought before the council, the meeting was adjourned.
