




# MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES



The Middletown Town Council held a meeting on April 19th 2022.


1. Council President Jake Smith appointed Cindy Justice-Smith as president of the Civic Center Board.
2. Ordinance 2022-2, an Ordinance creating a cell tower maintenance fund, was presented on its' third reading. Dave Wagner motioned Dan Fountain seconded approving the ordinance. Motion carried 5-0.
3. There was a proposal from IMPA to calculate new rates and provide more information on the repeal of the Utility Receipts Tax . The cost would be 172.80/hr with an estimate of 3 to 4 hours required. Baker-Tilly also prepared a proposal with a cost of up to 3,000 for each utility .Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded accepting the proposal from IMPA. Motion carried 5-0.
4. Resolution 04-19-2022-1, which resumes charging late fees on utility bills was presented. Dave Wagner motioned and Dick Schwalm seconded approving the resolution. Motion carried 5-0. Late fees will resume with the bill due May 15th.
5. Town Cleanup days will be June 2,3 and 4. We will have dumpsters at the wastewater plant for residents to use .
6. Carl Spears reported a problem with vehicles parked at 1301 Maple Street blocking the utility right of way.
7. Carl Spears requested that Kevin Miller be promoted to Grade 7 with a salary of 16.52/hr. Gary Kendall motioned and Dan Fountain seconded approving the request. Motion carried 5-0.
8. Carl Spears requested that Rick Hollingsworth be promoted to Grade 6 with a salary of 15.67/hr. Dave Wagner motioned and Dan Fountain seconded approving the request. Motion carried 5-0.
9. Carl Spears requested to hire Shannon Maddox part time at Grade 6 with a salary of 15.67/hr. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving. Motion carried 5-0.

There being nothing further brought before the council, the meeting was adjourned.
