


MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES


The Middletown Town Council held a meeting on May 3rd 2022.


1. Brad and Geneva Stewart questioned why it was made no parking across the street from the city building. It was explained that is was because of emergency vehicles being able to leave and return to the station more safely.
2. Resolution 05-03-2022-1, which amended the ARP spending plant to include payment of 82,700 to BFS, was presented. Dan Fountain motioned and Dave Wagner seconded approving. Motion carried 4-1 with Dick Schwalm voting no.
3. Ordinance 2022-3, which adjusts the Electric rates for removal of the Utility Receipts Tax, was presented on it's first reading. Dave Wagner motioned to approve and Gary Kendall seconded. Motion carried 5-0.
4. Ordinance 2022-4, which adjusts the water utility rates for the removal of the Utility Receipts Tax, was presented on its' first reading. Dave Wagner motioned and Dan Fountain seconded approving. Motion carried 5-0.
5. The condition of the Riley property was discussed. We have been told it will be cleaned up by May 15th.
6. Carl Spears requested that Kylee Alfrey be promoted to Grade 5 with a salary of 15.67/hr. Gary Kendall motioned and Dan Fountain seconded approving the request. Motion carried 5-0.
7. The June 7th meeting was moved to May 31st due to the Lions Club Fair being June 6-11.
8. Amanda Riwitis requested 5,000 from ARP funds to help pay for new bulletproof vests. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving the request. Motion carried 5-0
9. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded spending up to 6500 to put light on the new police vehicle we will be buying. Motion carried 4-1 with Dave Wagner voting no.
10. Dave Wagner motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving Mark Lohrey Masonry to block in windows at the sewer plant for 3500. Motion carried 5-0.

There being nothing further brought before the council, the meeting was adjourned.
