



MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES


The Middletown Town Council held a meeting on May 17th 2022. Dan Fountain was absent.

1. 414 Columbia, Tony Thompson is having sewer issues. Carl will have a camera run down it..
2. Derrick Resler water issue is still being discussed. No agreeable resolution has been found yet.
3. Ordinance 2022-3, which adjusts the Electric rates for removal of the Utility Receipts Tax, had it's public hearing. There was no comment from the public. Dave Wagner motioned to approve and Gary Kendall seconded. Motion carried 4-0.
4. Ordinance 2022-4, which adjusts the water utility rates for the removal of the Utility Receipts Tax had its' public hearing. Dave Wagner motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving. Motion carried 4-0.
5. The condition of the Riley property was discussed. If not cleaned up by May 31st, it will be turned over to the Town Attorney for further action.
6. The condition of the property at 456 N 8th was discussed. Because it is on the parade route, we want to make sure it is cleaned up before June 7th.
7. Carl Spears reported that Zachary Downard is no longer working for him. He requested to hire Ryan Surguy Part Time at Grade 5 to replace him. Dave Wagner motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving. Motion carried 4-0.
