



MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES


The Middletown Town Council held a meeting on May 31st 2022. Dick Schwalm was absent.


1. Chris Sanders from IMPA gave a solar farm update.
2. Derrick Resler water issue is still being discussed. No agreeable resolution has been found yet.
3. Ordinance 2022-3, which adjusts the Electric rates for removal of the Utility Receipts Tax, had it's 3rd and final reading. Dave Wagner motioned to approve and Gary Kendall seconded. Motion carried 4-0.
4. Ordinance 2022-4, which adjusts the water utility rates for the removal of the Utility Receipts Tax had its' 3rd and final reading. Dave Wagner motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving. Motion carried 4-0.
5. Ordinance 2022-5 which deals with golf carts and atvs on city streets was introduced. Dan Fountain motioned and Dave Wagner seconded passing the ordinance on its' first reading with some recommended changes. Motion carried 4-0.
6. Resolution 05-31-2022-1 which amends the ARP spending plan was read. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded pass ing the resolution. Motion carried 4-0.
7. Tony Thompson of 411 Columbia was present to discuss sewer issues. Carl Spears advised that it would be cameraed this week
8. Cindy Justice Smith discussed Civic Center rental issues..


There being nothing further brought before the council, the meeting was adjourned.


