



MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES


The Middletown Town Council held a meeting on September 6th 2022.


1. Jake Smith opened a public hearing on the 2023 budget. He then closed the hearing with no comment made by the public
2. There was discussion about the air conditioning on the second floor of the civic center..
3. Tony Thompson of 414 Columbia presented an invoice for fixing the damaged sewer lateral at that address. It is assumed that 3D company did the damage during stormwater separation a few years ago. Dave Wagner motioned and Gary Kendall seconded paying 7820.08 pending our attorney approving a release of the invoice submitted by L.K Wilson plumbing for the same project.
4. The council instructed Joel Harvey to send letters to Vic Eichhorn and Cody Riley about the condition of their properties.
5. Resolution 09-06-2022-1 was presented. It transfers title of the 1949 fire truck to the Historical Society. Dave Wagner motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving the resolution. Motion carried 5-0.
6. The council agreed to form a committee to help study the sewer plant expansion. Jake Smith, Dan Fountain, Carl Spears, Bob Tyler and Bill Ward.


There being nothing further brought before the council, the meeting was adjourned.
