



# MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES



The Middletown Town Council held a meeting on September 20<sup>th</sup> 2022.


1. Gary Redick from the Middletown Lions Club gave a presentation on the town sponsoring a service dog through the Lions Club.
2. Jake Smith opened a public hearing on Ordinance 2022-7. This ordinance annexes the property that IMPA is building a solar park on. President Smith then closed the hearing with no comment from the public. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving the ordinance on it's third reading. Motion carried 4-1. Dick Schwalm voted no.
3. Resolution 09-20-2022-1 , which amends the ARP spending plan to include a 2005 GMC dump truck from Pritchett's Backhoe Service, was introduced. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving the resolution. Motion carried 5-0.
4. The residents of 923 High Street notified the council of a utility pole in their backyard that is leaning to one side.
5. Dave Wagner motioned and Dan Fountain seconded hiring Jennifer Osborne as a part time dispatcher at Grade 5. Motion carried 5-0.
6. Dave Wagner motioned and Gary Kendall seconded instructing Joel Harvey to send Eichhorns a letter giving them 60 days to clean up the property at 829 Locust. Motion carried 5-0.
7. There will be a special meeting on Wednesday, October 5<sup>th</sup> to receive information about the PER for sewer upgrades.
