

MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

The Middletown Town Council held a meeting on October 4th 2022.

1. Ordinance 2022-7, which annexes the property for the IMPA solar farm, was read on its' third and final reading. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving the ordinance. Motion carried 4-1. Dick Schwalm voted no.
2. Ordinance 2022-8, which is the 2023 budget, was read. Dave Wagner motioned and Dan Fountain seconded approving the budget. Motion carried 5-0.
3. Jake Smith opened a public hearing on resolution 10-04-2022-1, which provides additional appropriations for Park Next Level Trails in the amount of 472,619.00. President Smith closed the hearing with no comment from the public. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving the resolution. Motion carried 5-0.
4. Resolution 10-04-2022-2, which preliminarily declares the property that IMPA is building a solar farm on as an Economic Revitalization Area was introduced. Dave Wagner motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving the resolution. Motion carried 4-1. Dick Schwalm voted no.
5. DC Construction pay request #3, which releases their retainage, was presented. Dave Wagner motioned and Dan Fountain seconded approving the request. Motion carried 5-0.
6. Peerless Midwest presented two invoices for working on pumps at the water plant. One was for 17,844 and the second was for 16,916. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded paying these out of ARP monies. Motion carried 5-0.
7. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded making Monday, October 31st as official tick or treat hours from 6:00 – 9:00 P.M. Motion carried 5-0.
8. It has been determined that the fire hydrants in Crestwood Mobile Home Park belong to the mobile home park. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded having Joel Harvey send a letter to Crestwood allowing our Fire Department use of the hydrants in case of emergency. Motion carried 5-0.
9. Dan Fountain motioned and Dick Schwalm seconded allowing the fire hydrant committee to continue working on hydrants that are in need of repair. Motion carried 5-0.
10. Brian Rednour reported that the old engine 31 will be donated to the Cadiz Fire Department.

There being nothing further brought before the council, the meeting was adjourned.
