



MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES


The Middletown Town Council held a meeting on October 18th 2022. Dave Wagner was absent.


1. A representative from Big B was present to discuss recent trash issues. They are having difficulty keeping drivers.
2. Doug Baldiseri, from Baker Tilly, presented a proposal for Baker-Tilly to conduct a rate study and assist in the financing of the proposed sewer project. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded accepting the proposal. Motion carried 4-0.
3. The paperwork to closeout CCMG 2021-2 grant was presented. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving the closeout. Motion carried 4-0.
4. There was discussion about the new trash contract. It will be continued at the next meeting.
5. There was discussion about trees being cut down at some residences in town.
6. Amanda Riwitis recommended that Clayton Harvey be promoted to Grade 5. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving. Motion carried 4-0.
7. There was discussion about the number of reserve officers that the Council will allow the Police Department to have.
8. Dick Schwalm suggested that we send Amanda Riwitis to Florida for a cave diving training. She is a member of the Sheriff Department dive team.
9. Carl Spears announced that we will begin leaf pickup on November 1st,
10. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded that we pay Culy contracting 24,000 for repairing a fire hydrant at 14th and Locust.


There being nothing further brought before the council, the meeting was adjourned.


