






# MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

The Middletown Town Council held a meeting on November 1<sup>st</sup> 2022.

1. Jake Smith opened a public hearing on the IMPA tax abatement. Chris Sanders from IMPA answered some questions from the public. President Smith closed the hearing.
2. Resolution 11-01-2022-1 Confirming the approval of the tax abatement was presented. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving the resolution. Motion carried 4-1. Dick Schwalm voted no.
3. There was discussion about the upcoming trash contract.
4. There was discussion about parking in the city building lot on weekends affecting fire trucks. Carl Spears and Amanda Riwitis will work on coming up with a solution.
5. BCW wants to connect to our sewer system, but we are having difficulty finding manholes in the area. They are not where the map shows them to be.
6. There was discussion about the electric service at the old car wash on 10<sup>th</sup> street. It is currently three phase. The new owner may not need three phase for his intended use of the facility..
7. Dan Fountain motioned and Dave Wagner seconded suspending tree removal until we develop a better policy for determining which trees are being removed. Motion carried 5-0.
8. Dan Fountain motioned and Dave Wagner seconded to approve paying a bill for 6300.00 for a tree being removed at 629 N 5<sup>th</sup>. Motion carried 3-2. Gary Kendall and Dick Schwalm voted no.
9. Dan Fountain motioned and Dick Schwalm seconded approving Ron Koons to apply for a grant for a cybersecurity analysis. Motion carried 5-0.
