

# MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

The Middletown Town Council held a meeting on April 4th 2023. Dan Fountain was absent

1. Tony Thompson of 414 Columbia questioned an easement for 3 phase electricity for building a garage. He was told it was 30 feet from the center of the pole.
2. The council discussed buying a cyber crime policy. Josh Estelle will be invited to the next meeting to discuss details.
3. The council tabled the bond ordinance for the sewer project due to the bond counsel still waiting on comments from SRF.
4. Dave Wagner motioned and Gary Kendall seconded accepting a quote from Scott's Computer Service for installing a computer and 75" tv in the council meeting room. The quote for 2500.93 does not include the price of the tv. Motion carried 4-0.
5. Dave Wagner motioned and Gary Kendall seconded accepting J&K Communications quote for 800 mhz radios for 153,459.68 and a repeater for 2,296.18. Motion carried 4-0.
6. Drew Cooper motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving Resolution 04-04-2023-1 which establishes a town election board for 2023. Motion carried 4-0.
7. The council accepted the Financial report for the Asset Management plan for the sewer project that was prepared by Baker-Tilly.
8. Dave Wagner motioned and Gary Kendall seconded adopting a policy allowing police officers off duty use of town vehicles. Motion carried 4-0.
9. Landon Dean recommended hiring Stacy Holzinger as a part time dispatcher at 15.00 per hour. Dave Wagner motioned and Drew Cooper seconded approving. Motion carried 4-0.
10. Landon Dean informed the council that Anthony Biddle has accepted a position with another department.
11. Landon Dean recommended hiring Wendel Jagers as a part time police officer at 18.38/hour. Dave Wagner motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving. Motion carried 4-0,
12. Landon Dean informed the council that Reserve Officer Richard Bilbrey has resigned his position.
13. Dave Wagner motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving having the pump in well #7 rebuilt for 14,231. Motion carried 4-0.

There being nothing further brought before the council, the meeting was adjourned.
