


MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

The Middletown Town Council held a meeting on April 18th 2023.

1. Tim Hill of Peerless Midwest was present to answer questions about the needed service on our well pumps.
2. Ordinance 2023-2, which authorizes the purchasing of bonds for our sewer project, was discussed. Dave Wagner motioned and Dan Fountain seconded passing the ordinance on its' third and final reading. Motion carried 5-0.
3. Bill Gabbard from Baker-Tilly , was present to discuss the timeline for the sewer project and a possible income survey.
4. 115 N 5th is having sewer issues. There was discussion on what options might be available to them.
5. Town Marshall Landon Dean expressed the need for radar for our vehicles. Dave Wagner motioned and Dan Fountain seconded approving buying two radars for 1633.00 each. Motion carried 5-0.
6. Carl Spears reported that a tree fell over the weekend at 913 Locust. It damaged a utility pole, a guardrail and the service lines to two neighboring houses.
7. The Wastewater Treatment Plant Committee made a recommendation on Phase 1 of the sewer project. They recommended that we use a Guaranteed Savings Contract to receive proposals for this phase. Dave Wagner motioned and Dan Fountain seconded accepting this proposal. Motion carried 4-1. Gary Kendall voted no.

There being nothing further brought before the council, the meeting was adjourned.
