







# MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

The Middletown Town Council held a meeting on May 16th 2023. Dan Fountain was absent.

1. Dave Wagner motioned and Gary Kendall seconded hiring Rolando Torres as a full time police officer. Motion carried 4-0.
2. Dave Wagner motioned and Gary Kendall hiring Mendenhall and associates to do an income survey for a cost not to exceed 1,000.00. This is part of the sewer project. Motion carried 4-0.
3. Dave Wagner motioned and Gary Kendall seconded hiring American Asphalt to repave the parking lot on 5<sup>th</sup> street by the Middletown News building. The quote is for 23,670.
4. Dave Wagner motioned and Gary Kendall seconded paying Butler Fairman Siefert 38,790.00 for services provided for the sewer project. It will be paid from the Electric Cash Reserve and reimbursed when the bond proceeds are received. Motion carried 4-0.
5. Dave Wagner motioned and Gary Kendall seconded paying BFS 2480.00 for the PER for the sewer project.
6. The June 6<sup>th</sup> meeting will be moved to June 13<sup>th</sup> due to the Lions Club Fair.
7. Two Hour parking downtown was discussed.
8. Dave Wagner motioned and Gary Kendall seconded hiring Josh Grizzell as a part time dispatcher at 15.00 per hour. Motion carried 4-0.
9. The council approved Landon Dean appointing Rick McCorkle and Marty Dulworth as Special Reserve Deputies.
10. Rolando Torres was sworn in as a full time police officer by Clerk-Treasurer Tim Mundell.
11. Jake Smith motioned and Gary Kendall seconded Moving Clint Ade to Grade 8 Utility worker at 16.77 per hour.
12. Dave Wagner motioned and Gary Kendall seconded hiring Dalton Kaiser as part time utility help for the summer. He will be paid minimum wage. Motion carried 4-0.
