





MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

1. Ordinance 06-20-2023, which allows police officers to work overtime for 50.00/hour at the chiefs' discretion, had its' second reading. This money will be reimbursed by the Federal Government. Dave Wagner motioned and Dan Fountain seconded approving. Motion carried 4-0.

5. Carl Spears requested that Steven Hill be hired as a part time utility worker at Grade 11 17.86/hr. Dave Wagner motioned and Dan Fountain seconded approving. Motion carried 4-0.
6. Dan Fountain motioned and Jake Smith seconded approving free rummage sales during the Fall Funfest. Motion carried 4-0.
