



# MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES


The Middletown Town Council held a meeting on July 18th 2023.  
Jake Smith and Drew Cooper were absent

1. Ordinance 06-20-2023, which allows police officers to work overtime for 50.00/hour at the chiefs' discretion, had its' third reading. This money will be reimbursed by the Federal Government. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving. Motion carried 3-0.
2. Ordinance 2023-2, which is the sewer bond ordinance, had its' second reading. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving. Motion carried 3-0.
3. The council agreed to have Carl Spears get quotes for paving the alley behind the Methodist church between 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> streets.
4. There was discussion about the Riley property at 303 N 13<sup>th</sup>. There have been numerous attempts to get them to clean up the property. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded having Joel Harvey begin legal action against them. Motion carried 3-0.
5. There was discussion about having two hour parking limits downtown. No action was taken.
