The council approved minutes from the November 7th meeting.


The council approved claims 38805 – 38895 for 274,370.42


1. Jerry Harter, from AMBIT Enterprises, gave a presentation on a proposed new phone system. Dan Fountain motioned and Drew Cooper seconded installing the new system for a cost of 6079.23. Motion carried 4-0.
2. Sherry Underwood, of 1402 Locust, expressed concerns about a sewer smell at her property. The council will have BFS look into a short term solution for the problem.
3. There was discussion about credit card fees and the customers paying them instead of the town. No action was taken.
4. Bids were opened for the 2018 police Silverado. The bids received were:


Anthony Taylor 18,004.00

Shenandoah School Corporation 15,152


Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded accepting the bid of 18,004.00 Motion carried 4-0

7. Phil Chandler requested the town vacate 12th street north of High until it dead ends at the Honey Creek trail. The town will research this.


There being nothing further brought before the council, the meeting was adjourned.
