

MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES


The Middletown Town Council held a meeting on December 5th 2023. Dave Wagner was absent


The council approved minutes from the November 21st meeting.


The council approved claims 38896 – 38964 for 277,370.31

1. Jake Smith opened a public hearing on additional appropriations to the Police Public Safety LIT. Smith closed the hearing with no comments from the public.
2. Resolution 12-05-2023-1, which approves additional appropriations of 20,000 to the Police Public Safety LIT was introduced. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded approving. Motion carried 4-0.
3. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded to pay the Hydrant Rental Fee out of the General Fund in 2024 instead of adding it as a user fee on the utility bills. Motion carried 4-0.
4. Clerk-Treasurer advised the council what the SBOA charged each utility and the town for the recent audit.
5. Clerk -Treasurer Tim Mundell advised the council on how much money the town would be reimbursed for expenses paid toward the sewer project once the bond closes.
6. Landon Dean reported that the Police Department tagged 32 vehicles since the last meeting.
7. Ron Koons gave a presentation on grants available through IMPA for AMI metering. The council took it under consideration.

There being nothing further brought before the council, the meeting was adjourned.
