


MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES


The Middletown Town Council held a meeting on April 2nd 2024. Drew Cooper and Ryan Smith were absent.


The council approved the minutes from the March 19th meeting
The council approved claims 39434 - 39489 totaling 398,889.32


1. Thomas Ballenger of 932 Progress, questioned why a vehicle was towed from his property. It had previously been tagged as inoperable, but he claimed that it was operable when it was towed. He requested that he be reimbursed the impound fees. That request was denied. He was told that the vehicle is currently parked in a town right of way and needs to be moved. He told the council that it would be moved by the morning of 04/03/2024.
2. Resolution 04-02-2024-1, which updates the ARP spending plan to include payments to Maddox Industrial of 17,975 for repairing the clarifier drive and 16,150 for replacing a bearing in the sewer plant biotower was presented. Dan Fountain motioned and Teresa Dennis seconded approving. Motion carried 3-0.
3. The cleaning contract for Clean N Simple for the city building was presented. The council agreed they would rather have a month-to-month contract instead of a two year agreement. They also want language about automatic renewal removed. We will present these changes to the company.
4. Dan Fountain motioned and Teresa Dennis seconded hiring Madison Lyall as a full time dispatcher. Motion carried 3-0.
5. Carl Spears presented estimates to bring our electric trucks up to code. Dan Fountain motioned Teresa Dennis seconded fixing the trucks. Motion carried 3-0.


There being nothing further brought before the council, the meeting was adjourned.
