



MIDDLETOWN TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES


The Middletown Town Council held a meeting on January 17th 2023. Dave Wagner was absent.


1. The council opened the bids for trash pickup. The bids were:
Big B 13.10
Best Way 14.25
Waste Management 18.00.
Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded taking all bids under advisement. Motion carried 4-0.
2. There was discussion about the status of interfund loans. We are behind on some payment plans. Drew Cooper will look into this and try to come up with a solution.
3. The invoice from Peerless Midwest for rebuilding pump #1 in the water plant was presented. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded paying yhe invoice out of ARP monies. Motion carried 4-0.
4. Charlotte Harman reported a dip in the road at the corner of 10th and High that seems to be getting worse.
5. Amanda Riwitis submitted her letter of resignation as Town Marshall effective February 5th. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded accepting the resignation. Motion carried 4-0.
6. Amanda Riwitis recommended Jim Hunt as the new Town Marshall.
7. Dan Fountain motioned and Gary Kendall seconded naming Jim Hunt as interim Town Marshall effective February 6th.
8. Dan Fountain discussed the break schedule of the utility workers.
9. Dan Fountain reported that Vic Eichhorn has hired a contractor to start cleaning up the property on Locust Street.
10. Drew Cooper reported that the Shenandoah School Corporation is forming a committee to discuss what can be done with the old gym. They would like the Town Council to be represented on the committee.


There being nothing further brought before the council, the meeting was adjourned.


