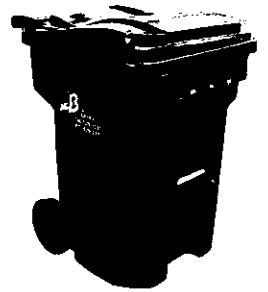


MIDDLETOWN TRASH TOTE RULES



Since February 4, 2020 Middletown has proudly benefited from Big B being contracted to be our single source trash hauler. Since then this family owned operated business in Henry County has done a great job and has corrected any problems in a

timely manner. Plus Middletown residents have saved money monthly by having a less expensive service that the Town was able to contract for our town residents.

Now its time for all of us to come together and help to be in com-

pliance of our Town Ordinance 12-14-2019, "Regulations on the Collection and Disposal of Refuse". To sum this up, its our opinion that the word needs to get out to those that may not know or understand the rules of the Trash Service in Middletown.

REGULATIONS ON THE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF REFUSE

- ◆ All trash shall be bagged and placed in the 96 gallon Tote. (Ord.2A)
- ◆ No person shall place Prohibited Waste in any Tote (Ord. 2A)
- ◆ Prohibited Waste is motor oil, gasoline, paint, flammable liquids, batteries, construction debris and other materials designated as hazardous waste described and delineated in 40 CFR §261, et seq. and any other material or items that Big B will not collect as part of its routine collection of refuse.
- ◆ All containers (Totes) shall be placed adjacent to the street no earlier than Noon 12:00 p.m. on the day (Monday) immediately prior to the collection day (Tuesday) and shall be moved to a location that is not visible from any place on the right-of-way no later than 10:00 p.m. on the day (Wednesday) after collection. (Ord.2A)
- ◆ The trash in the Tote must be placed in the container in such a manner that the lid on the container will completely close. (Ord.2A)
- ◆ Trash must be placed in the container (Tote) and shall not be placed on the ground adjacent to the container or in any other location visible from the right-of-way or abutting properties. (Ord.2A)
- ▶ **PENALTIES:** Any person violating the provisions of section 2(A) shall be fined in the sum of twenty five dollars (\$25.00) for the first violation, fifty dollars (\$50.00) for the second violation and a sum of up to one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each subsequent violation.

LARGE Waste Items: Large items that cannot fit in the Trash Tote or larger items such as couches, bed mattresses, and furniture, can be disposed of by contacting Big B by calling (877) 529-2337 (all bed mattresses and box springs, along with cloth furniture, must be wrapped in a plastic cover for the health, safety and welfare of the Big B employees)

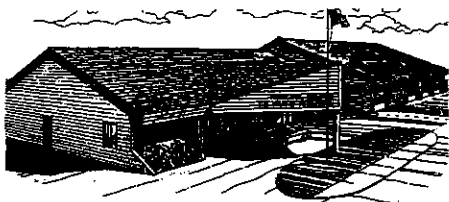
- All trash shall be bagged and placed in the Big B Tote. (Ord.2A)
- No person shall place Prohibited Waste in any Tote. (Ord.2A)
Prohibited Waste: Motor oil, gasoline, paint, flammable liquids, batteries, Construction Debris and other materials designated as Hazardous Waste described and delineated in 40 CFR §261, et seq. and any other material or items that Big B will not collect as part of its routine collection of refuse.
- Totes shall be placed adjacent to the street no earlier than (Noon) 12:00 p.m. on the day (Monday) immediately prior to the collection day (Tuesday) and shall be moved to a location that is not visible from any place on the right-of-way no later than 10:00 p.m. on the day (Wednesday) after the collection. (Ord.2A)
- The trash in the Tote must be placed in the container in such a manner that the lid on the container will completely close. (Ord.2A)
- Trash must be placed in the container and shall not be placed on the ground adjacent to the container or in any other location visible from the right of way or abutting properties. (Ord.2A)

PENALTIES

Any person violating the provisions of section 2(A) shall be fined in the sum of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for the first violation, fifty dollars (\$50.00) for the second violation and a sum of up to one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each subsequent violation.

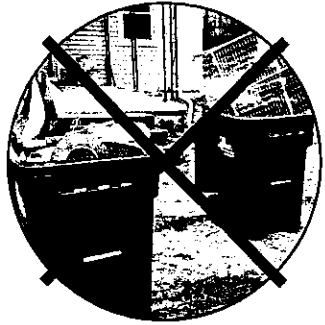

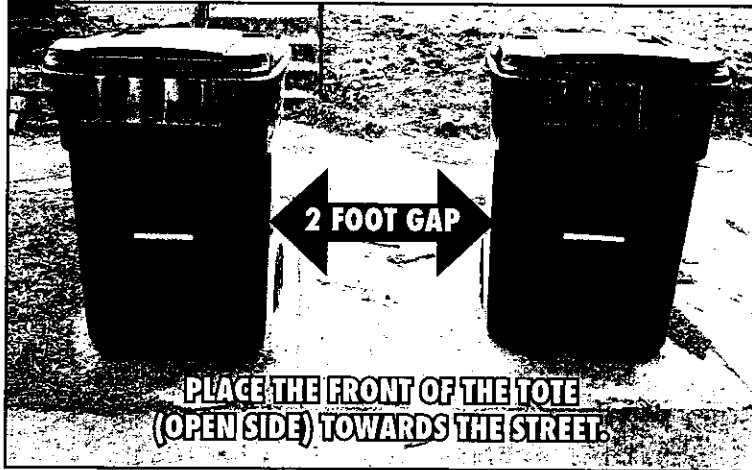
MIDDLETOWN TRASH TOTE RULES



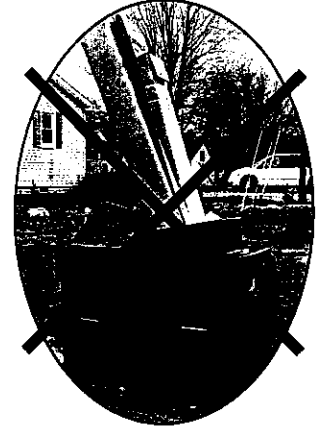
EXAMPLE OF CORRECT TOTE PLACEMENT



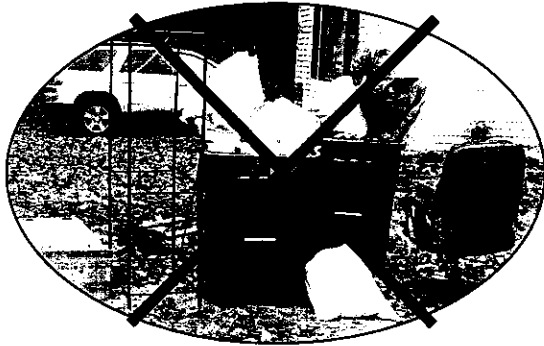
If the lid is not properly closed this will result in the damage and sometimes the removal of the lids when the truck empties the totes.



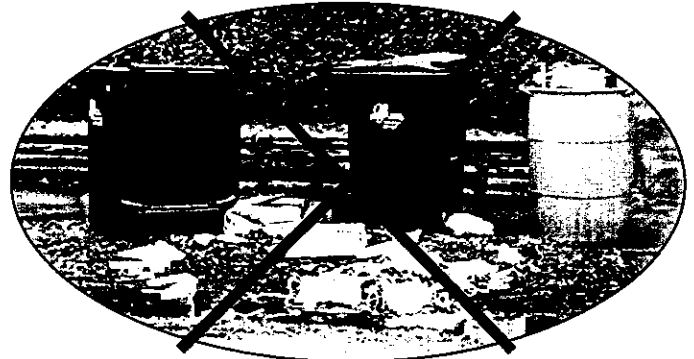
PLACEMENT OF THE TWO (2) OR MORE TOTES SHALL BE PLACED NEXT TO EACH OTHER WITH A 2 FOOT GAP BETWEEN EACH TOTE.



The trash in the tote must be placed in the container (Tote) in such a manner that the lid on the container will completely close.



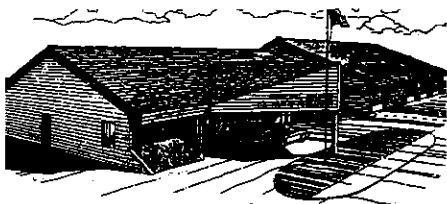
Trash must be placed in the container (Tote) and shall not be placed on the ground adjacent to the container or in any other location visible from the right-of-way or abutting properties



When Trash is not in Trash Bags, this will result in items from the trash tote being dropped and scattered on the ground during the removal process because of the wind.

OTHER SIMPLE GUIDELINES WHEN PREPARING YOUR TRASH MATERIAL FOR COLLECTION...

- ◆ Trash Totes must be placed far enough away from mailboxes, trees, utility poles, and fire hydrants. Please look up to ensure no Utility Lines will be damaged from your placement of the Tote(s).
- ◆ When placing the tote by the street please place the front of the tote (Open Side) towards the street.
- ◆ According to Federal Law, Big B is not permitted to accept batteries, tires, liquid and combustible materials or any items identified as hazardous.
- ◆ Concrete, Bricks, Rocks and Dirt are not acceptable.
- ◆ Placement of the two (2) or more Totes shall be placed next to each other with a 2' foot gap between each Tote.
- ◆ If the lid is not properly closed this will result in the damage and sometimes the removal of the lids when the truck empties the totes. When Trash is not in Trash Bags, this will result in items from the trash tote being dropped and scattered on the ground during the removal process because of the wind.
