The Board of Morrow County Commissioners intends to apply for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) PY2022 -- Allocation program funding. This is a federally-funded program administered by the Ohio Department of Development's Office of Community Development. The Board of County Commissioners will conduct the First Public Hearing on May 16 at 3 p.m. by WebEx and in person at 80 N Walnut St., Mount Gilead, in the Hearing Room; and the Second Public Hearing will be on June 6 at 3 p.m. by WebEx and in person at 80 N Walnut St., Mount Gilead, in the Hearing Room. **Community applications are due to the Morrow County Development Office by Noon June 6, 2022.**

The Second Public Hearing will provide attendees information about the 2022 CDBG Allocation grant program, including an explanation of eligible activities, program requirements, applications received to date by priority, recommendations regarding the project, and subsequent submission to the Ohio Department of Development for funding consideration. The activities must be designed to primarily benefit low or moderate-income persons, or aid the prevention or elimination of slum and blight, or meet an urgent community need. Morrow County is eligible to apply for \$172,000.

Final state approval is expected by September 2022, and therefore no project may commence until such time. Grant recipients should expect projects to start by December 2022. All approved projects must be completed by October 31, 2024.
