The Land Value added to the assessable Residential Building Value equals your property's Assessed Value.

The Assessed Value minus any property exemptions, equals the Taxable Value. Any questions about your Assessed Value or Exemptions should be asked to the Assessment Office. Their phone number is 217-728-4951.

The Taxable Value multiplied by the Tax Rate (See below for how that is calculated) equals your Property Tax amount. This will be your Total Amount unless you have Drainage Tax on your property. That will be added to your Total Amount Due.

This box shows the breakdown for how your Tax Rate is calculate. You will see your Prior Year and the Current Year. The Tax Rate is the combined amount that your taxing bodies are requesting. Your Tax Bodies may include:

- Your Village or City
- Your Local Emergency Services
- Your Local School District

IMPORTANT LATE FEE INFORMATION

Pursuant to 35 ILCS 200/21-15, for property located in a county with fewer than 3,000,000 inhabitants, the unpaid taxes shall bear interest at the rate of 1.5% per month, or portion thereof. If paying late, please make sure to include the interest penalty in your payment. The payment scale on each installment stub includes the proper penalty amounts for each date range.

Important Payment Information:

- Post-dated checks are not accepted
- Returned checks are subject to \$25 fee plus penalties
- No grace period
- Your cancelled check is your receipt unless a self-addressed stamped envelope is provided
- After certified notice, payment must be made by cash, cashier's check, or money order

Property Tax Exemptions

The following exemptions may be available to qualifying property owners:

- General Homestead (Owner-Occupied) Exemption (up to 6,000)
- Leasehold Owner-Occupied Exemption
- Senior Homestead Exemption (up to 5,000)
- Senior Citizens Assessment Freeze Exemption
- Homestead Improvement Exemption
- Natural Disaster Homestead Exemption
- Homestead Exemption for Persons with Disabilities (up to 2,000)
- Disabled Veterans' Standard Homestead Exemption
- Disabled Veteran Exemption
- Returning Veterans' Homestead Exemption (up to 5,000)

Important Information

1. **This is the only tax bill you will receive.** Include the payment stub with each installment if mailing payment.
2. **Failure to receive a bill does not waive penalties, even if you do not receive a bill.** Taxpayers are responsible for payment by the due date.
3. **Bills are mailed to the Taxpayer of Record.** If you are not responsible for payment, forward to correct party or return to Collector/Treasurer for correction.
4. **Mortgage Company Payments** - If taxes are escrowed, keep this notice and verify payment status with your lender before paying. Forward bill to lender if required.
5. **Late Payment Penalty (Illinois Law)** - 1.5% penalty is added beginning the day after the due date and each month thereafter. Any part of a month counts as a full month. A certified letter or publication of delinquent tax will result in an additional \$10 charge.
6. **Taxpayer Responsibilities** - Examine bill carefully. Verify property description, details, and exemptions. Report address changes to the Supervisor of Assessments. Failure to receive a tax bill or receiving one late for any reason will not relieve taxpayer from paying taxes or late penalties.
