

1. This notice is given to all residents of mail ballot precincts in Murray County, Minnesota.
2. On March 5, 2024, the State of Minnesota is holding a Presidential Nomination Primary.

4. Eligible voters not pre-registered by February 13, 2024, or pre-registered voters wishing to receive their ballot at a temporary address may contact the Murray County Auditor's Office by phone 507-836-1154, mail or in person for an absentee ballot application.
5. Registered mail ballot voters will be sent all three major political party ballots to their residence by February 20, 2024.
6. Mail ballot voters will choose the ballot of the party with which they are in general agreement with their principles and **only vote and return that one ballot**.
7. The unused ballots are to be destroyed and discarded by the mail ballot voter and **NOT** returned in the voted ballot envelope packet.
8. Voters must record their party choice on the signature envelope. The voter's choice of a party will not be a part of a public information list but will be shared with the chair of the major political party that they select.
9. The voted ballot may be returned by mail (a postage prepaid return envelope is included), or may be delivered in person, or delivered by designated agent to: Murray County Auditor's Office 2500 28<sup>th</sup> Street, Slayton, MN 56172. Ballots must be received no later than 8:00 p.m. on Election Day in order to be counted. Normal business hours are Monday-Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Secure drop boxes are available at the north and south entrance of the Government Center (2500 28<sup>th</sup> Street, Slayton, MN 56172).
10. In addition to the normal business hours, extended hours for mail ballot voting are:  
Saturday, March 2, 2024 from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.  
Monday, March 4, 2024, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
11. The polling place for mail ballot precincts on March 5, 2024 is:  
Murray County Government Center  
Auditor's Office  
2500 28<sup>th</sup> Street, Slayton, MN 56172  
The polls will be open: 8:00 AM - 8:00 PM. At least one assistive voting device will be available at the polling place; allowing for persons with disabilities to vote privately and independently.
