

PROCEEDINGS OF THE MURRAY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

Pursuant to notice, the Murray County Board of Commissioners convened with the following members present: Commissioners James Jens, David Thiner, and Dennis Welgraven. Also present was Economic Development Director Amy Rucker. Excused absences: Commissioners Lori Gunnink and James Kluis.

Chief Deputy Sheriff Heath Landsman updated the Board on flooding conditions within the County.

Commissioner Jens introduced the following resolution and moved for its adoption:

RESOLUTION DECLARING A STATE OF EMERGENCY
RESOLUTION 2019-03-28-01

WHEREAS spring flooding due to heavy snow has impacted the population of Murray County and its cities; and

WHEREAS the flooding event has caused a significant amount of public property damage; and

WHEREAS the Murray County Department of Emergency Management requests the Murray County Board of Commissioners to declare Murray County in a STATE OF EMERGENCY for the spring flooding event of 2019;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Murray County Board of Commissioners declared Murray County in a State of Emergency for conditions resulting from the spring flooding due to heavy snow melt starting on March 23, 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that this is for a period of thirty (30) days.

The foregoing resolution was duly seconded by Commissioner Welgraven with all members voting in favor.
