

PROCEEDINGS OF THE MURRAY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

September 13, 2019 8:30 a.m. Emergency Meeting

Pursuant to notice, the Murray County Board of Commissioners convened with the following members present: Commissioners David Thiner, James Jens, James Kluis, and Dennis Welgraven. Also present was Economic Development Director Amy Rucker. Excused absence: Commissioners Lori Gunnink.

Emergency Management Director Justin Koch updated the Board on flooding conditions within the County.

Commissioner Welgraven introduced the following resolution and moved for its adoption:

RESOLUTION DECLARING A STATE OF EMERGENCY  
RESOLUTION 2019-09-13-01

WHEREAS flooding due to heavy rains has impacted the population of Murray County and its cities; and

WHEREAS the flooding event has caused a significant amount of public property damage; and

WHEREAS the Murray County Department of Emergency Management requests the Murray County Board of Commissioners to declare Murray County in a STATE OF EMERGENCY for the flooding event of 2019;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Murray County Board of Commissioners declared Murray County in a State of Emergency for conditions resulting from flooding due to heavy rains starting on September 10, 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that this is for a period of thirty (30) days.

The foregoing resolution was duly seconded by Commissioner Kluis with all members voting in favor.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:32 a.m.
