

PROCEEDINGS OF THE MURRAY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
FALL ROAD TOUR
September 30, 2019 8:00 a.m.

Pursuant to notice, the Murray County Board of Commissioners met at the Highway Department in Slayton for the Fall Road Tour. The following members were present: Commissioners Lori Gunnink, Jim Kluis, James Jens, David Thiner, and Dennis Welgraven. Also present, County Administrator Tom Burke, County Engineer Randy Groves, Parks & Fairgrounds Director Justin Hoffmann, and Community Transit Bus Driver Terry Lingen.

Everyone gathered at the Highway Department and the Road Tour began at 8:00.

County Engineer Groves distributed the five-year road plan. The Board checked several roads and bridges that are slated for upcoming projects. They also made stops at Lime Lake Park in Avoca, looked at the Avoca dam, visited the Fulda Depot Annex Building and Seven Mile Lake Park, made a stop at the End-O-Line Railroad Park and Museum in Currie, looked at the dikes at Lake Shetek, and visited Sundquist and East Lake Sarah County Parks. They reviewed recent work done at the dam in Hadley and the beginning of County Ditch 11. They looked at land near Slayton for a potential new Highway Department location and took a short tour of the existing Highway Department. They also visited the fairgrounds and looked at various buildings from past construction and for future construction projects.

No action was taken.

Following the Road Tour, the meeting was adjourned in Slayton at 12:45 p.m.
