TERMS FOR BORROWED FUNDS PAYBACK

The existing loan from Murray County to SAWS for \$175,000 with a 2-year repayment plan was discussed.

SAWS RATE REVIEW

It was moved by Gunnink, seconded by Jens, and passed to approve the SAWS recommendation to raise the monthly rates for residential and commercial pumps with a special surcharge of \$10 per pump for 2 years and a 3% annual increase of the base rates.
