The Murray County Parks & Recreation Advisory Commission convened on September 24, 2019 at East Lake Sarah County Park. - The Sundquist Park project is pretty much complete except for the playground installation and the fire rings and picnic tables need to be assembled at the accessible sites. The bathroom and sidewalks took longer than anticipated. The contractor received a few deadline extensions from the County Board.
- Parks personnel started spraying this week and hope to finish this week.
- Lime Lake Park flooded during the mid-September rain storm.
- Aerators will be installed at Bloody Lake and Lake Shetek within the next 2 – 3 weeks.
- Brochures racks at the parks have had to be refilled as people are taking the new Parks brochures.
- Mowing is not done for the season.

Old Business:

David Thiner suggested striping or some sort of demarcation of parking spaces by the boat launch at East Lake Sarah.

Sundquist Park Project Update
