Update on Delayed Hookups:

The SAWS attorney shared with the Board the options when dealing with the delayed hook ups not already in compliance. One option would be to file a lawsuit requiring them to connect as required by the Ordinance, which could be costly. The second option would be for the attorney to send the remaining delayed hookups a letter giving them a final opportunity to connect before a lawsuit will be filed.

- ➤ Motion (7/9/18a) Moved by Dave Maguire and seconded by Greg Grant to have SAWS attorney send a letter to remaining delayed hookups. Motion carried unanimously.
- ➤ Motion (7/9/18b) Moved by Donna Kor, seconded by Harley Wahl to begin legal proceedings after deadline on letter if connections are not completed. Motion carried unanimously.

Minutes:

➤ Motion (7/9/18c) Moved by Harley Wahl, seconded Greg Grant to approve the minutes from the previous meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Treasurers report:

- ➤ Motion (7/9/18d) Moved by Greg Grant, seconded by Dave Maguire to approve payment of the invoices totaling \$26,489.79. Motion carried unanimously.
- ➤ Motion (7/9/18e) Moved by Harley Wahl, seconded by Greg Grant to approve payment of the invoices totaling \$9,931.26 related to insurance claim. After further discussion, the motion failed.
- ➤ Motion (7/9/18f) Moved by Donna Kors, seconded by Harley Wahl to approve payment of Slayton Plumbing & Heating and Enviro Pump Plus invoices related to insurance claim. Motion carried unanimously.
- ➤ Motion (7/9/18g) Moved by Harley Wahl, seconded by Greg Grant to send letters to individual landowners about decision on insurance claim. Motion carried unanimously.
- ➤ Motion (7/9/18h) Moved by Donna Kors, seconded by Greg Grant to table 2019 budget until next month. Motion carried unanimously.

Engineers report:

- 1. Dave Brown had to leave on a call so Blake tried to fill in what he could.
- 2. Discussed storm damage and documentation being done by Dave Brown, Blake Heronimous, Jean

Christoffels, and Sarah Soderholm.

- 3. We have about 40 pumps that may qualify for disaster relief, perhaps more along with other equipment.

- 4. Discussed the emergency discharge necessary due to the heavy rains. MPCA approval was determined prior to emergency discharge.
- 5. Issues with Lift Station #3 and #4 were discussed. MPCA was notified prior to the bypass during the flash flooding. Also, Quality Flow was involved with pump issues.

Other:

- 1. Discussion was had on delinquent sewer bills.
 - ➤ Motion (7/9/18j) Moved by Donna Kors, seconded by Greg Grant to send letters to landowners with delinquent sewer bills. Motion carried unanimously.
- 2. Discussion was had on the annual rate review.
 - ➤ Motion (7/9/18k) Moved by David Maguire, seconded by Donna Kors to have the SAWS Board conduct the annual rate review. Motion carried unanimously.
- 3. Follow-up discussion was had related to sewer billing questions at 29 Valhalla Dr.
 - ➤ Motion (7/9/181) Moved by Harley Wahl, seconded by Dave Maguire to forgive the late fees associated with the months in question. Motion carried unanimously.
- 4. Conversation was had regarding the pipe extension on the Inlet.
 - ➤ Motion (7/9/18m) Moved by Donna Kors, seconded by Dave Maguire to table discussions until next month. Motion carried unanimously.
- 5. Dave Brown will continue to look at pontoon/ boat options for the ponds when treating is necessary.
