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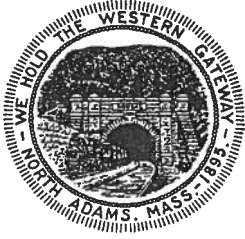

Rule # 25

If a Councilor or Councilors want a legal opinion from the City Solicitor, they must put the request on the agenda with an explanation of what they are looking for and what they have done to date to take advantage of freely available information. The Council will then discuss and vote. A simple majority will decide the question.

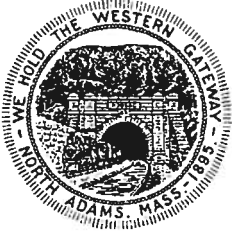

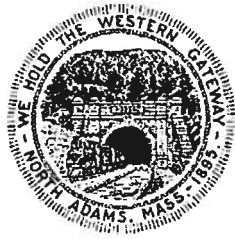

Using the most recent cruiser purchase price of \$55,200 and a life span of \$125,000 miles, I am using .44 as rough depreciation. Using the average miles per year x .44 cents per mile, I came to the following conclusions:

- #19: \$10,467
- #20: \$6,657.20
- #21: \$14,671.44
- #22: \$11,913.88
- #23: N/A 2020
- #24: \$9,135.20
- #25: \$6,246.24

Keeping the fleet at 16,640 average per year would decrease these numbers to \$7,321.60 per vehicle using the same numbers noted above.

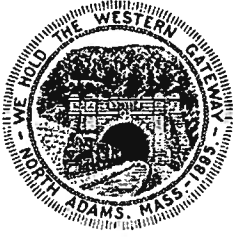
