

**Request For Proposals
City of North Adams
RFP/Bid # NA-2018-023**

The City of North Adams, MA, acting by and through its Office of Community Development (OCD), is soliciting proposals from not-for-profit social service agencies and/or from licensed providers to implement their agency's services/programs that will benefit low/moderate income persons that reside in North Adams, especially those services that help sustain and improve the economic security and self-sufficiency of the affected individuals. Proposals shall be reviewed by the City's Human Services Commission with assistance provided by the OCD. An anticipated total of \$30,000 to \$40,000 will be sought for this campaign, which envisions assisting up to no more than five eligible agencies.

Project RFPs are available at the North Adams Office of Community Development, City Hall, after 12:00 P.M. on Thursday, September 20, 2018, or can be viewed on the municipal website of www.northadams-ma.gov. Proposals must be received no later than 2:00 PM on Thursday, October 18, 2018, at the Office of Community Development, Room # 213, City Hall - 10 Main Street, North Adams, MA 01247, after which time all received proposals shall be taken to the second floor conference Room # 218 where they shall be opened and identified as to its proposer. All proposals will receive consideration without regard to race, creed, color, age, sex, religion or national origin.

This project is slated for funding from the City's *FY'2019 Community Development Block Grant* from the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development, pursuant to Title I of the Housing & Community Development Act of 1974, and is contingent upon the City's official award of said funding on or about July 1, 2019 from the State Department of Housing & Community Development, having secured its executed Grant Agreement from said funding source as well as meeting any other post-award grant requirements.
