

LEGAL NOTICE
B-2020 Roadway Improvements
Bid # NA-2021-003

The City of North Adams, Massachusetts, through its Office of Community Development (OCD), the Awarding Authority, invites sealed bids for roadway resurfacing and associated improvements thereto for North Holden Street and Liberty Street in accordance with the documents prepared by the OCD.

The project seeks to conduct a "mill and fill" resurfacing type of project with related work thereto for the entire lengths of Liberty Street (approx. 1,990 x 21 LF) and North Holden Street (approx. 1,320 x 22 LF). The project is estimated to cost \$146,130 with the total number of days to Final Completion set for seventy-five (75) days.

Contractors must be pre-qualified by the MassDOT's Highway Division in order to be an eligible bidder.

Wages are subject to Massachusetts minimum wage rates as per M.G.L. Chapter 149, Section 26 to 27H inclusive, and the Federal minimum wage rates pursuant to the Davis-Bacon Act, whichever pays more.

Sealed bids will be received until **9:00 am, Friday, May 28, 2021** at the City's OCD, Room 107, City Hall, 10 Main Street, North Adams, MA 01247, after which time all bids will be taken to the OCD Conference Room # 110, to be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids shall be filed in a sealed envelope bearing the title "**Bid # NA-2021-003**" and delivered pursuant to the project's instructions.

Mailed Bids should be sent to the City of North Adams, OCD, Room 107, City Hall, 10 Main Street, North Adams, MA 01247 and received no later than the date and time specified above.

General bids shall be accompanied by a Bid Deposit that is not less than five (5%) of the greatest possible bid amount (considering all Alternates), and made payable to the City of North Adams.

Plans and specifications will be available at the OCD after 12:00 pm, May 12, 2021, and can be sent electronically at no cost with a request to: ocd@northadams-ma.gov. If by mail, there will be a plan deposit of \$20.00 per set (maximum of 2 sets) payable to the City of North Adams.

This project is funded through the City's *FY'20 CDBG/Mini-Entitlement Grant* from the Department of Housing and Community Development, under the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) pursuant to Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, with other possible funding through the City's *FY'20 Chapter 90* appropriation.

The lowest-priced bid from the most qualified and responsible bidder shall be awarded the project subject to the availability of funding. The City of North Adams reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities in the bidding. No obviously unbalanced bid will be considered in awarding this contract.
