DBA Omak-Okanogan County Chronicle as a legal newspaper in 17 Okanogan County pursuant to RCW Ch. 65.16. 18 II. STATEMENT OF FACTS 19 The Omak-Okanogan County Chronicle ("the Chronicle") is a weekly newspaper serving 20 Okanogan County. See Declaration of Teresa Myers ("Myers Decl.") at ¶ 3. The Chronicle 21 publishes local and national news and does not focus on any particular group or subject area, is 22 printed in English, and is a newspaper of general circulation. Id. at ¶4. The Chronicle is 23 published in Omak, WA, in Okanogan County and has been since 1910. Id. at ¶5. It has a 24 ALLIED

The <u>Omak-Okanogan County Chronicle</u> has been published on a weekly basis, in the English language, since 1910. <u>See</u> Teresa Myers Decl. at ¶¶3-5. The <u>Omak-Okanogan County Chronicle</u> is published in Omak, Washington, in Okanogan County, and has been published in Okanogan County since 1910. <u>Id</u>. at ¶¶3-5. The <u>Omak-Okanogan County Chronicle</u> has a periodical class mailing permit, USPS – 408-300. <u>Id.</u> at ¶6. It is in general circulation rather than distributed to a distinct group or class of individuals. <u>Id</u>. at ¶¶4, 6. It has a policy to publish all properly submitted legal notices. <u>Id.</u> at ¶7.

The Omak-Okanogan County Chronicle publishes news of general interest and is not focused on one specific organization, group, or class. Id. at ¶4. The content of the Omak-Okanogan County Chronicle is far broader than that of publications that have been found to be too specific to qualify as a "legal newspaper." For example, in **Daily Journal of Commerce**, Inc. v. Daily Journal Corporation, 86 Wn. App. 324, 936 P.2d 1179 (1997), Division I ruled that the "Washington Journal" (published by Daily Journal Corporation) did not contain news of general interest because it contained primarily news that was of particular interest to lawyers. 86 Wn. App. at 329-330. The Court noted that a "vast majority [of articles] are closely related to legal issues, proceedings, and subjects. Its news is predominantly special interest news, and it does not contain news of general interest, as opposed to news primarily of interest to a class." **<u>Id</u>**. at 330. Even though some articles could be of interest to the general community, the primary focus on legal issues supported the Court's finding that the "Washington Journal" was not a legal newspaper because it did not contain "news of general interest." Id. at 332. The Court went on to state that "In context, the phase 'shall contain news of general interest as contrasted with news of interest primarily to an organization, group or class,' requires the publication to dedicate itself to topics in such a way as to ensnare a broad-based readership." Id. The Omak-Okanogan

2	County Chronicle does not focus on any particular area of news and covers a wide variety of		
3	perspectives and thus "ensnares broad based readership" as required by Daily Journal .		
4	VI. CONCLUSION		
5	Because the Omak-Okanogan County Chronicle meets all qualifications for a legal		
6	newspaper as required by RCW 65.16.020, it respectfully requests that this Court enter an order		
7	approving the status of the Omak-Okanogan County Chronicle as a legal newspaper in		
8	Okanogan County, WA, pursuant to RCW 65.16.040.
