

**OKANOGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS'**  
**RESOLUTION 9 – 2022**

*A resolution amending resolution 67-2021 and 138-2021 to exclude from the 2022 assessment land owned by Washington state and the United States*

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners approved resolution 67-2021 and 138-2021 regarding the Okanogan County Horticulture and Pest Control 2022 assessment; and

**WHEREAS**, the Assessor recommended on January 5, 2022, that state and federal lands be excluded from the 2022 assessment;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners that paragraph 9 of resolution 67-2021 and paragraph 4 of resolution 138-2021 be amended and the words "and/or state and federal lands" be struck out so that state and federal lands are not included in the 2022 assessment and shall not apply specifically to Trust Indian Land under the control of the Bureau of Indian Affairs or the Colville Confederated Tribes, or to any other lands owned by the United States; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** all other recitals of resolution 67-2021 and 138-2021 shall remain in effect.
