RESOLUTION 13 - 2021

A resolution promoting Juvenile Deputy Prosecuting Attorney

WHEREAS, the Chief Criminal Deputy Prosecuting Attorney resigned their position effective January 26, 2021; and

WHEREAS, section 3.3.2 of the County Personnel Manual provides for the promotion of an employee into a higher classification; and

WHEREAS, the Elected Official has the authority to place an employee at a Step 3 without Commissioner approval as long as the employee has the skills and ability to warrant starting higher than the beginning step; and

WHEREAS, Felecia Chandler was initially hired in the Prosecuting Attorney's Office on June 14, 2004 as a District Court Deputy Prosecutor; and

WHEREAS, Felecia Chandler's proven work performance, training, experience, and increased responsibilities are all good cause to promote her to the vacated position of Chief Criminal Deputy Prosecutor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners that effective January 27, 2021, Felecia Chandler is promoted from the classification of Juvenile Deputy Prosecuting Attorney (PRO016PJV-001), Grade 36, Step 5, to the classification of Chief Criminal Deputy Prosecutor (PRO016PCR-001), Grade 45, Step 3.


